MPact Global Action for Gay Men's Health and Rights (formerly known as MSMGF or The Global Forum on MSM & HIV) was founded in 2006 by a group of activists concerned about the disproportionate HIV disease burden shouldered by men who have sex with men.

MPact works at the intersection of sexual health and human rights, and is linked to more than 120 community-based organizations in 62 countries who are leading innovative solutions to the challenges faced by gay and bisexual men around the world.

Job Description

The Communications Intern will work with MPact's Sr Communications Officer to help promote meaningful global communication on issues concerning gay and bisexual men and HIV. Primary responsibilities of the Communications Intern will include:

- Crafting and scheduling content for social media
- Supporting the update and maintenance of www.mpactglobal.org
- Regular blog posting on MPact's work and global issues pertaining to the latest news and reports on LGBTQI issues and HIV worldwide
- Assisting with additional responsibilities as needed

An internship with MPact provides a unique opportunity for students/graduates interested in engaging on topics related to sexual health and human rights with a specialized focus on inequity, discrimination, and advocacy for marginalized communities.

The Communications Intern should be working towards a degree related to public health, global policy, communications, or some related field.
